



UniSA Eagles Flag Football

The flag football tournament will operate from 6:30pm until 9pm on Wednesday nights from May 1stth until June 24rd, 2015.

There is a total of 50 minutes allocated for each game, encompassing two 20-minute halves and a 5-minute break at half time and after the game to transition teams on and off the field.

In order to ensure people are able to finish the game before an unreasonable time, we will run two fields side-by-side, ensuring there is a referee operating each field and all games are finished by 9:00pm.

Each team will be provided with a Team Registration Form, Player Waiver Forms and Flag Football Rules.

Each ground that a game is played on will require the following;

- 1 official per field, umpires flag and 1 whistle
- 1 game ball
- 20 player flags (10 of each colour per team)
- 8 end zone pylons (or cones or a different colour)
- 12 no running zone markers (different colour)

The referees will be responsible for setting up the field each week, collecting team fees, keeping time in the games and ensuring the smooth running of the flag football program.

All fees will be provided to the Flag Football Coordinator prior to each teams game, who will balance the money, ensure each team has paid registration and each player has signed waiver forms prior to playing.



UniSA Flag Football Team Conditions

In order to register a team within the UniSA Flag Football competition, the team must meet the following criteria

- Have a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 10 players in your team.
- Pay the \$80 team registration fee prior to the first game (May 1st, 2019).
- Ensure the team registration form is signed by the Captain.
- Hand in a team registration form prior to the first game (May 1st, 2019).
- Ensure all players have produced their Waiver Form, signed prior to the first game (May 1st, 2019).
- Provide a minimum of 5 players per week, otherwise the team will forfeit the game due to lack of players.
- Acknowledge the team must pay a \$100 forfeit fee (\$50 for each team affected) before playing the week after forfeiting.
- A player must play a minimum of 3 games and be registered to the team all season to be eligible for finals.
- A team must provide a team name and uniform colours for submission by April 28th, 2019 – teams providing this first will get **priority of name/colours**.
- As a team, we acknowledge that flag football is a non-contact sport and no member of our team will engage in tackling or blocking of any player.
- The referee's decision will be final at all times.
- Each team must nominate one Captain as the main point of contact for the team.
- There is to be no abusive conduct towards a referee or member of any other team at any time.

By signing, all players acknowledge that as individuals and as a team, they will follow the Flag Football Rules and referees instructions.

UniSA Flag Football Player Waiver Form

In consideration of being allowed to participate in any way in UniSA Eagles' Flag Football sports program, related events and activities, the undersigned acknowledges, appreciates, and agrees that:

- 1) The risk of injury from the activities involved in this sport may be significant, despite being a predominantly non-contact sport. I acknowledge flag football is non-contact and that I will not engage in tackling or blocking of players.
- 2) I knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of the releasees or others, and assume full responsibility for my participation; and,
- 3) I willingly agree to comply with the stated and customary terms and conditions for participation. If, however, I observe any unusual significant hazard during my presence or participation, I will remove myself from participation and bring such to the attention of the nearest official immediately; and,
- 4) I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, hereby release and hold harmless UniSA Eagles, their officers, officials, agents, and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the event ("releasees"). With respect to any injury, disability, death or loss or damage to person or property, whether arising from the negligence of the releases or otherwise to the fullest extent of the law.
- 5) If I have any pre-existing condition that may result in inflammation or a re-occurring injury or produce a new injury that concerns me, I acknowledge I have talked to a medical professional prior to playing this sport.
- 6) I understand the UniSA Eagles Flag Football program may use my pictures on social media and I authorise these to be used to promote flag football in South Australia by the UniSA Eagles.

I have read this release of liability and assumption of risk agreement, fully understand its terms, understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it and sign it freely and voluntarily without inducement.
